Empowering Action: A Recap of SDG Action and Awareness Month 2025!



The opening ceremony on March 10th marked the beginning of this year's SDG Action and Awareness Month, focusing on vital themes such as energy saving, upcycling, mental wellness, and racial equality.

At the beginning of the school year, our College participated in an interview with the UNESCO Hong Kong Association (UHKA) regarding the application of AI in education for sustainable development. Our school-based Academic Integrity Policy serves as a guideline. The event featured an exciting lineup of activities designed to engage students and promote awareness.

Participants tested their aim at the Nerf Gun Recycling Target Shooting Challenge and explored racial equality through a specially designed board game created by the committee.

Students also spread hope for the SDGs by creating unique stickers and cards, while showcasing their knowledge in the Kahoot quiz competition centered around energy-saving practices.

From March 17th to 20th, an open session was held during lunchtime, featuring booths that promoted sustainability and offered delicious, sustainable food and drink options.

Second Annual LOHAS Festa, Promoting Sustainability and Stewardship Through Student-Led Initiatives

Every March, St. Paul's College collaborates with various partners to blend sustainability and healthy lifestyles with stewardship, extending the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into student-led activities. This approach empowers students to apply their knowledge in real-world contexts.

On March 15, the **second annual LOHAS (Lifestyles of Health and Sustainability) Festa** brought together nearly 100 teachers and students from five secondary schools on Hong Kong Island.

Participants engaged in seven interactive workshops led by Student Sustainability Ambassadors, emphasizing environmental awareness and mindful consumption.



A standout workshop featured a **campus treasure hunt**, highlighting how schools can reduce carbon emissions. The collaboration between St. Paul's boys and St. Francis' girls inspired plans for future green initiatives promoting low-carbon living.

Father Amos from St. John's Cathedral led an **origami workshop** that invited reflection during Lent, encouraging participants to "tend the soil of their hearts" and foster unity and care for both people and nature.
